

IV. Bible Study Interpretation

The best book on the subject still: Protestant Biblical Interpretation by: Bernard Ramm

- **▶ Inductive Bible Study** The KEY to knowing the Bible
- **▶** Interpretation Two Basic Principles
 - ✓ **Careful Observation** of the Text and the Message of the Text Historical and Literary (Contextual Observation who, what, where, when, why.)
 - ✓ Comparative Observation (Compare with other Scriptures)
- **→** Application

This is much dependent upon the general maturity, sanity, background, mental set, personality, *Sitz im Leben*, and other factors of the individual.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR EVERYBODY ON EARTH: The interpretation will have ONE basic meaning (sometimes there is discussion among biblical interpreters as to what exactly IS the intended meaning). REMEMBER THIS: Your application and that of any other human being can be wrong. So, be careful in "applying" the Bible to your situation without sound thinking and teaching to back it up. The Holy Spirit is there (within in you) to guide you and open up the Scriptures (called, *illumination*) to you, **IF** you listen to Him and not the mere desires of your own heart and mind.
